



Two views to the north and to the southeast. The Snake River is to the right and just beyond the tree line in the picture on the right.



This view is to the northeast. In the far upper left corner is an elevated goose nest. Waterfowl are already using the area and the vegetation along the banks is clearly becoming well established.

This view is to the south, with the Snake River just beyond the tree line. The islands in the wetland areas will provide “predator free” nesting and rearing habitat for waterfowl. The Idaho Dept. of Fish and Game, a long time cooperator with this landowner is working to establish vegetation along the banks of the area to encourage upland birds.
